The ecological footprint of plastic bags in our environment is unbearable and the European and Spanish authorities have been working for some time towards their elimination.

Much of the plastic we consume ends up in the sea

They are one of the most common products and also one of the most harmful.

Each Spaniard consumes an average of 238 plastic bags per year.

They take more than 500 years to disappear and only 10% of them are recycled.



- We should use cloth bags, reusable or traditional bags made from natural fibres when we go shopping.
- Plastic, glass and paper, direct to their recycling container, without a bag!
- Separate and dispose of organic waste in their corresponding containers in organic or biodegradable bags.
