## WASTE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (WEEE)

From August 2018, the categories of equipment and their waste will be reduced to SEVEN CATEGORIES, according to the Royal Decree 110/2015, of February 20, on electrical and electronic equipment and the management of their WEEE waste.

## **# CATEGORIES:**

- 1. Heat exchange appliances
- 2. Monitors, screens and devices with screens with a surface area above 100 cm<sup>2</sup>
- 3. Lamps
- 4. Large appliances (with external dimension above 50 cm)
- 5. Small appliances (with no external dimension above 50 cm)
- 6. Small computer and telecommunications equipment
- 7. Large photovoltaic panels



**REMEMBER:** All devices that need cells, batteries or an electrical current are ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT and become WEEEs when discarded.
