

WASTE ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (WEEE)

ENVIRONMENTAL
TIPS **#75**

From August 2018, the categories of equipment and their waste will be reduced to **SEVEN CATEGORIES**, according to the Royal Decree 110/2015, of February 20, on electrical and electronic equipment and the management of their WEEE waste.

CATEGORIES:

1. Heat exchange appliances
2. Monitors, screens and devices with screens with a surface area above 100 cm²
3. Lamps
4. Large appliances (with external dimension above 50 cm)
5. Small appliances (with no external dimension above 50 cm)
6. Small computer and telecommunications equipment
7. Large photovoltaic panels



REMEMBER: All devices that need cells, batteries or an electrical current are **ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT** and become **WEEEs** when discarded.
