



## RESULTS

The results obtained in the calculation of the Port Connectivity Index (ICP) for the second half of 2020 show some significant changes with respect to the previous half-year period at some Spanish ports.

The ICP corresponding to the second half of 2020 reflects the changes in connectivity of Spanish ports in Short Sea Shipping (SSS) traffic. In this regard, it appears that the ICP continues to reflect the effects of COVID-19 on shipping services, as the vast majority of ports studied show a fall in connectivity levels.

The table shows how Valenciaport continues to lead the ranking for another half-year period and while it has seen a slight drop in connectivity for the second consecutive semester, this latest drop is primarily due to the lower number of shipping companies. Algeciras retains second position, having also seen a reduction in connectivity in respect of the previous semester due to the reduction in the number of shipping companies. Finally, Barcelona takes third place in the ranking after three consecutive months of falls in connectivity levels caused especially by the reduction in the number of lines. Among the rest of the ports that make up the TOP 10 best connected in SSS, general performances have seen a slight fall in connectivity. Also worth noting is the entry into the ranking of Tenerife, occupying the last position.
