The ozone layer is a fragile cover of gas that protects the Earth from the harmful effects of the sun's rays, thus helping to preserve life on the planet.

However, the use of certain chemicals over the years has damaged it, endangering our own existence and that of other living things on the planet. A concerted international effort has led to the elimination and reduction of the use of ozone-depleting substances, helping not only to protect the ozone layer, but also to improve the performance of efforts to tackle climate change.
